

T3.7 Accreditation process start

Serbian Project Partners are going to submit 9 new study modules for accreditation (6 study modules predicted in WDT) and to develop 2 new study courses.

Accreditaion documents are submitted for 6 study modules in July 2019, with 3 study modules to be submitted for accreditation, no latter than March 2020:

1. Undergraduate / specialized modules (6 modules),
University of Belgrade, Faculty of Security Studies.
Status: submitted for accreditation on July 4th
2019.
2. Master study modules (2 modules):
 - a) Educons Unviersity (1 master module). Status:
Module structure defined, to be submitted for
accreditation in March 2020.

- b) University of Criminal Investigation and Police Studies, with participation of professors from University of Defence in Belgrade (1 master module). Status: Module structure defined; to be approved by Ministry of Interior and Ministry of Defence, expected in February 2020, to be submitted for accreditation in March 2020.
3. PhD study module, Educons University, with participation of professor from University of Defence in Belgrade. Module structure defined, to be submitted for accreditation in December 2019.
4. Belgrade Metropolitan University does not participate in accreditation of new study modules, but it will prepare 2 new courses under this Project:
- a) Cybersecurity and blockchain, and
 - b) Ethics and Data Policy (with participation of professor from Educons University)



In order to further improve quality of education in area of safety and security, Partners recognized the need for knowledge and experience sharing; therefore, 2 new study modules (1 master and 1 PhD) and 1 new study course predicts involvement of professors from both home HEI and professors from 3 other Serbian HEIs.
